# Z2 SETTLEMENT REPORTING

- Z2 Crediting Implementation required the creation of new charge types
- Built to distinguish between:
  - Payments, Credits and Revenue Reallocations
  - PTP and NITS activity where needed
  - Specific Schedule buckets where needed
  - Interest and 'normal' buckets where needed
    - **NOTE**: As a result of Stakeholder input

New Z2 Manual Adjustment Charge Types can fit into 3 categories:

- A. Revenue Reallocation Charge Types
- **B.** Sponsor's Financial Activity Charge Types
- **C.** Miscellaneous Adjustment Charge Types (specific to Z2 activity)

- A. <u>Revenue Reallocation Charge Types</u>: Amounts reclaimed from revenues previously allocated to T.O.s to help satisfy Credit Payment Allocations
- 1. PTP Revenue Reallocation Credit (credits received by a Sponsor from revenues previously allocated to a T.O. for PTP service).
- **NOTE:** This section should appear on XML for entities receiving credit payments. Would be associated with an Upgrade Sponsor, not a Transmission Owner. All Upgrade Sponsors are classified as Transmission Customers for the purpose of Attachment Z2.

- A. <u>Revenue Reallocation Charge Types</u>: Amounts reclaimed from revenues previously allocated to T.O.s to help satisfy Credit Payment Allocations
- 2. PTP Revenue Reallocation Credit Revenue Reversal (likened to a charge to the T.O. shows amount clawed back from previously allocated PTP revenue).
- **NOTE:** This section should appear on XML for entities having revenues pulled back. Would be associated with a T.O.

- A. <u>Revenue Reallocation Charge Types</u>: Amounts reclaimed from revenues allocated to T.O.s to help satisfy Credit Payment Allocations
- 3. Nits Revenue Reallocation Credit (credits received by a Sponsor from revenues allocated to a T.O. for NITS service).
- **NOTE:** This section should appear on XML for entities receiving credit payments. Would be associated with an Upgrade Sponsor. No designation between Zonal and Regional.

- A. <u>Revenue Reallocation Charge Types</u>: Amounts reclaimed from revenues allocated to T.O.s to help satisfy Credit Payment Allocations
- 4. Nits Revenue Reallocation Credit Revenue Reversal (likened to a charge to the T.O. shows amount clawed back from allocated NITS revenue).
- **NOTE:** This section should appear on XML for entities having revenues pulled back. Would be associated with a T.O.

  - Z2Sch11ZNitsRRCreditRevRvrs

B. <u>Sponsor's Financial Activity Charge Types</u>: Credits received from charges to a T.C. "over and above" <u>Base Rate</u> charges, which are needed to satisfy a Credit Payment Obligation. This occurs when the payer's Credit Payment Obligation > Base Rate Revenues.

NOTE: No Tariff Schedule is associated with these charge types. This is done to alleviate the need to separate a single DAUC into multiple Tariff Schedule buckets

#### **1.** Z2 PTP Credit (credits received by a Sponsor from a T.C. for PTP service).

- **NOTE:** This section should appear on XML for entities receiving credit payments. Would be associated with an Upgrade Sponsor.

B. <u>Sponsor's Financial Activity Charge Types</u>: Charges to a T.C. "over and above" Base Rate charges, which are needed to satisfy a Credit Payment Obligation. This occurs when the Credit Payment Obligation > Base Rate Revenues.

NOTE: No Tariff Schedule is associated with these charge types. This is done to alleviate the need to separate a single DAUC into multiple Tariff Schedule buckets

#### 2. Z2 PTP Credit Charge (credits paid to a Sponsor from a T.C. for PTP service).

• **NOTE:** This section should appear on XML for entities paying credit payments. Would be associated with a T.C. for normal crediting activities.

B. Sponsor's Financial Activity Charge Types: Credits received from charges to a T.C. "over and above" <u>Base Plan</u> funded amounts, which are needed to satisfy a Credit Payment Obligation. This occurs when the Credit Payment Obligation > Safe Harbor Cost Limit, or other Base Plan funding criteria are not met.

**NOTE:** No Tariff Schedule is associated with these charge types.

- 3. Z2 Nits Credit (credits received by a Sponsor from a T.C. for NITS service).
- **NOTE:** This section should appear on XML for entities receiving credit payments. Would be associated with an Upgrade Sponsor.
  - Z2DANitsCredit
  - Z2DANitsCreditInt

- B. <u>Sponsor's Financial Activity Charge Types</u>: Charges to a T.C. "over and above" <u>Base Plan</u> funded amounts, which are needed to satisfy a Credit Payment Obligation. This occurs when the Credit Payment Obligation > Safe Harbor Cost Limit, or other Base Plan funding criteria are not met.
- **NOTE:** No Tariff Schedule is associated with these charge types.
- 4. Z2 Nits Credit Charge (credits paid to a Sponsor from a T.C. for NITS service).
- **NOTE:** This section should appear on XML for entities paying credit payments. Would be associated with a T.C. for normal crediting activities.

• Z2DANitsCreditChg

- **C.** <u>Miscellaneous Adjustment Charge Types</u>: Miscellaneous Adjustment to monetary amounts within the CSS tool.
- NOTE: Can be used to zero out/adjust an amount to be paid or received.

#### **Miscellaneous Adjustment Charge Types**

- **NOTE:** This section should appear on XML for any entity being charged or credited by a manual adjustment within the CSS tool. These will be associated with both a T.C. and a T.O.
